Negative: (отрицателна форма)	I <u>didn't play</u> chess. He <u>didn't</u> study	I <u>haven't played</u> He <u>hasn't</u> studi <u>ed</u>
,	I <u>didn't see</u> a bear He <u>didn't ride</u> a bike yesterday.	I <u>haven't seen</u> a bear. He <u>hasn't ridden</u> a bike.
Interrogative: (въпросителна форма)	Did you <u>play</u> chess? Did he <u>study</u> ? Did you <u>see</u> the bear? Did he <u>ride</u> a bike yesterday?	Have you <u>played</u> chess? Have you <u>studied</u> Spanish? Have you <u>seen</u> a bear? Has he <u>ridden</u> a mountain bike?
Short answers:	Yes, I did. / No, I didn't. Yes, he did. / No, he didn't.	Yes, I have. / No, I haven't. Yes, he has. / No, he hasn't.
